Assembly

Cut the building from the sheet using a hobby knife or scissors. If using a hobby knife, be sure to use a straight edge for a clean accurate cut. Colour the "white" edges of each cut using a marker or paint. Be careful not to get paint or marker on the front of the sheet by colouring the cut edge from behind with the tip pointing toward the front.

Suggested Uses:

Cut and place directly on backdrop.
Glue to foam board or cardstock and mount in front of backdrop.
Cut out extra sides and fix in place to form a 3-sided building
Individual buildings can be cut and rearranged to fit your layout.
Layer buildings to force perspective and add more depth.
Smaller scale buildings imply greater depth.

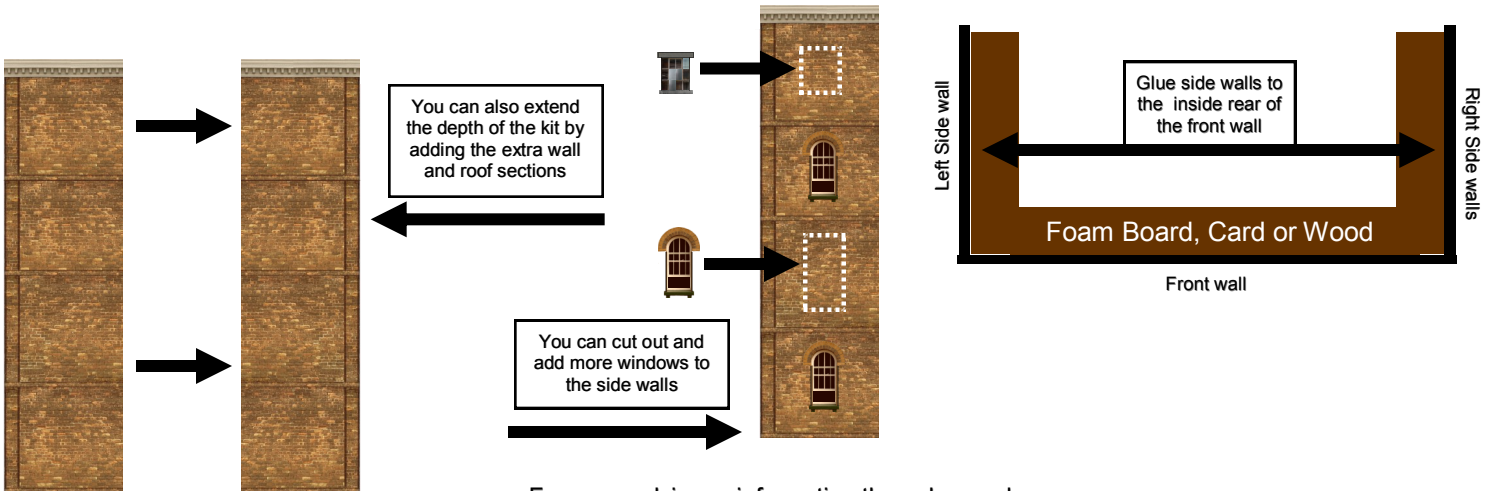
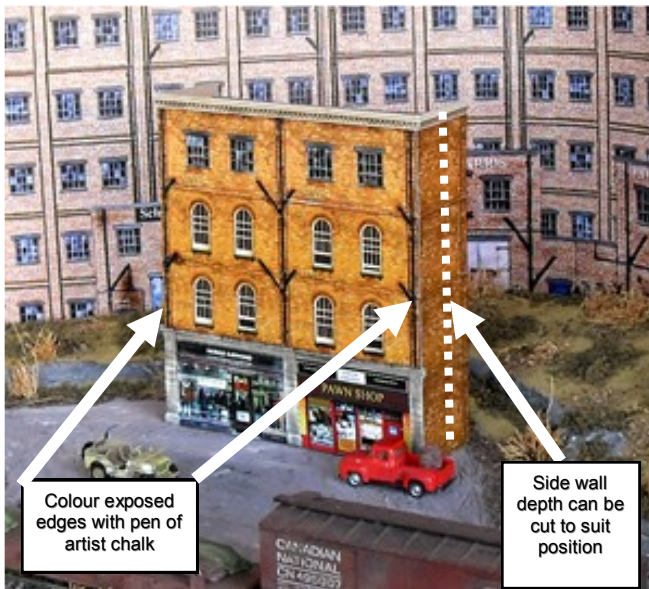
If you are going to fix your sheets to cardstock or mounting board (foam core, wood, etc), test fit the sheets to them and secure the support pieces to a base. Allow for overlap at the corners. The base can be foam board, wood or other rigid sheet material.
